

THE NORTH WEST YOUTH COMMISSION REPEAL ACT,

ACT

To provide for the repeal of the North West Commission Act, 1994; to provide for the disestablishment of the North West Commission; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the North West Province as follows:-

1. **Definitions** – in this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise -

"**Commission**" means the Provincial Youth Commission established by section 2 of the Act;

"Premier" means the Premier of the Province of North West as contemplated by section 145(1) of the Constitution;

"Province" means the North West Province as established in terms of section 103(1)(h) of the Constitution;

"The Act" means the North West Youth Commission Repeal Act, 2009.

## **2. Disestablishment of the North West Youth Commission**

(1) The Provincial Youth Commission, a body established in terms of section 2 of Act No. 14 of 1994 is hereby disestablished.

(2) Subject to the provisions of subsection (1), the term of office of all members of the Commission who are still in office immediately at the commencement of this Act are hereby terminated.

(3) The chairperson of the Commission shall transfer all books and records of the Commission to the Director General in the Office of the Premier.

## **3. Transfer of powers, functions, rights, duties and obligations of the Commission**

(1) Any power, function, right whether tangible or intangible or vested or not, of the Commission whether such power or right is conferred by or arises from contractual agreement or otherwise prior to the disestablishment of the Commission shall vest in the Office of the Premier.

(2) All movable assets of the Commission shall be transferred to and vest in the Office of the Premier.

(3) All liabilities and obligations, whether contingent or vested or latent, of the Commission, whether such liability or obligation is assigned by or arises

from contractual agreement or otherwise, shall be transferred to the Office of the Premier immediately at the commencement of this Act.

- (4) The Office of the Premier shall in respect of assets, liabilities, rights, duties and obligations so transferred to it be deemed to be the successor in law of the Commission.

#### **4. Repeal of laws and savings**

- (1) The laws appearing in the Schedule attached hereto are repealed to the extent indicated in the third column of the Schedule.
- (2) Notwithstanding the repeal of any law in terms of subsection (1), anything done under any such law by the Commission and which could have been done under a provision of any such law shall be deemed to have been done lawfully in terms of this Act.

#### **5. Short title and commencement**

This Act is called the North West Youth Commission Repeal Act, 2009 and shall come into operation on the date of promulgation.
